Scholarship Selection Committee: Alumni Council Scholarship Committee members, Alumni Association CEO, UL Lafayette Scholarship Officer

Award: \$2,000 for one academic year (\$1,000/Fall, \$1,000/Spring) – must maintain GPA to sustain. Student cannot receive a UL Lafayette Alumni Association Endowed Scholarship more than once.
